8.31 Recommendation: The Board enters into an agreement with Richland County Board of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities to provide one-on-one educational services for a special needs preschool student for 10 hours per week or 150 hours maximum commencing on 2/27/2009 and terminating on 6/4/2009 at a rate of \$11.07 per hour, not to exceed \$1,660.50.

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 3311.059 provides that a board of education of a local school district may, by resolution, propose to sever itself from the territory of the educational service center which it is currently included and to annex itself to the territory of another educational service center, the current territory of which is adjacent to the territory of the educational service center in which the local school district is currently included; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of the Clear Fork Valley Local School District is currently serviced by the Mid-Ohio Educational Service Center; and;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of the Clear Fork Valley Local School District has determined that it would be in the best interests of the School District to be serviced by the Knox County Educational Service Center, said territory lying adjacent to the territory of the Mid-Ohio Educational Service Center;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Education of the Clear Fork Valley Local School District, pursuant to R.C. 3311.059, proposes to sever the Clear Fork Valley Local School District from the territory of the Mid-Ohio Educational Service Center and to annex to the territory of the Knox County Educational Service Center.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this annexation to the territory of the Knox County Educational Service Center shall be effective, according to statute, on July 1, 2010 if the annexation is approved by the governing board of the Knox County Educational Service Center County on or before June 30, 2009 and there is no valid referendum petition submitted within 60 days of the adoption of this Resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this annexation to the territory of the Knox County Educational Service Center shall be effective, according to statute, on July 1, 2011 if the annexation is approved by the governing board of the Knox County Educational Service Center County after June 30, 2009, but on or before June 30, 2010, and there is no valid referendum petition submitted within 60 days of the adoption of this Resolution; or if a valid referendum petition is submitted within 60 days of the adoption of this Resolution, the board of elections certifies the results of the referendum election on or before June 30, 2010. If the annexation is approved by the governing board of the Knox County Educational Service Center on or before June 30, 2009 and a valid referendum petition is submitted within 60 days of the adoption of this resolution, then this annexation shall be effective on July 1, 2011 provided the board of elections

certifies the results of the referendum on or before June 30, 2010.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Treasurer is directed to file a copy of this resolution with the governing board of the Knox County Educational Service Center, the governing board of the Mid-Ohio Educational Service Center and the Superintendent of Public Instruction.
