

ADMISSION OF STUDENTS
FROM NONCHARTERED OR HOME SCHOOLING

~~If a parent wishes to have his/her child return to a District school, he/she must follow normal enrollment guidelines and local District policy.~~

~~Students entering the District from a nonchartered or home schooling program will be admitted if said student enrolls in a minimum of one academic core content course (English, Language Arts, Math, Science, or Social Studies) per semester on a space available basis. Students so enrolled will be permitted to participate in extracurricular activities. Athlete eligibility (grades 7-12) will be determined by OHSAA and District athletic policy.~~

~~In grades K-8, if the student wishes to enroll, the parent must provide an academic assessment for each school year of course work. In addition, the school will assess the student by using the previous year's local competency based education or State practice proficiency test. The student's placement will be determined by the Superintendent/designee.~~

~~In grades 9-12, if the student wishes to enroll, the parent must provide an academic assessment report for each class taken. In addition, the school will need the grades from the last public or private school attended. Athletic eligibility (7-12) will be determined by OHSAA guidelines and District athletic policy.~~

~~All home based, private education courses, courses from nonchartered schools and courses from outside of the U.S. will be given a grade of P/F (Pass/Fail) and transcripts will denote "home education," "nonchartered," "out of U.S.," with P/F grades and credits assigned.~~

~~To receive credit in courses, the returning student may be required to demonstrate proficiency. Proficiency will be determined by the local school administration or its designee. For example, a returning student might present an art portfolio for assessment to demonstrate proficiency in art or be required to take a semester or final exam.~~

~~The student's grade point average will be established only after he/she has completed two consecutive semesters of attendance within the high school. To be eligible for awards such as graduation awards, distinguished scholar, Ohio Academic Scholarship, National Honor Society, etc., the student must be enrolled for three consecutive semesters prior to the second semester of the senior year.~~

~~Before a diploma can be presented, students must meet all State and local requirements.~~

Students seeking admission into the District's schools who have been enrolled in nonchartered schools or home schooling programs may be required to take

competency examinations. The purpose of these examinations is to determine the proper grade placement for these students.

In making a placement decision, the Superintendent may consider:

1. the student's most recent annual academic assessment report;
2. whether to require the student to take any or all of the nationally normed, standardized achievement tests that are regularly scheduled for the District students of similar age and
3. other evaluation information that may include interviews with the student and the parent.

Resident students attending a nonchartered nonpublic school are permitted to participate in the District's extracurricular activities at the school to which the student would be assigned if the nonchartered nonpublic school the student is enrolled in does not offer the extracurricular activity. Students must be of the appropriate age and grade level as determined by the Superintendent and must fulfill the same academic, nonacademic and financial requirements as any other participant.

Resident students receiving home instruction in accordance with State law are permitted to participate in District extracurricular activities at the school to which the student would be assigned. Students must be of the appropriate age and grade level as determined by the Superintendent and must fulfill the same academic, nonacademic and financial requirements as any other participant.
